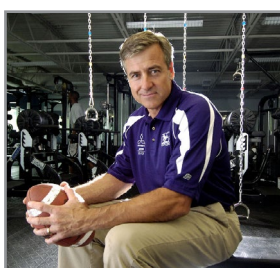

Greg Marshall began his football career as a fullback for the Western Mustangs and later played professionally for the Edmonton Eskimos where he won a Grey Cup in 1982. He coached the Hamilton Tiger-Cats for three years and was named CFL Coach of the Year in his rookie year. Greg has been head coach of the Western Mustangs since 2007. Marshall's 12 seasons behind the Mustangs bench have been marked by success as he has taken his teams to the Yates Cup in 10 of the 12 seasons of his tenure and won six (2007, 2008, 2010, 2013, 2017, 2018). In 2017 he coached the Mustangs to a win in the national championship (Vanier Cup).

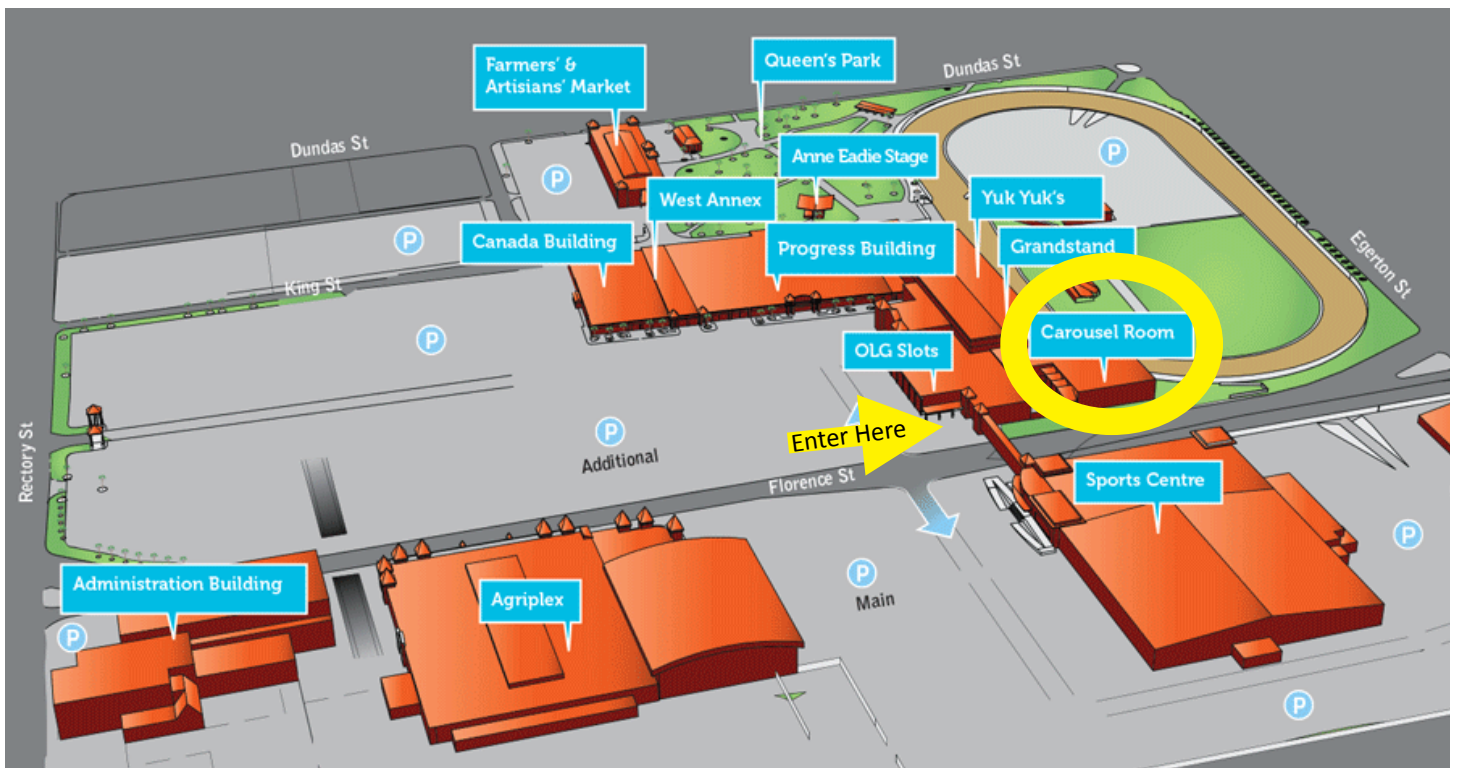
**Euan Scofield Student Leader - ManUp [www.manupinspire.com](http://www.manupinspire.com)**
