The Centre for Research & Education on Violence Against Women & Children launched a lecture series in 2021 to honour Dr. Peter Jaffe, a psychologist and professor emeritus at the Faculty of Education. Dr. Jaffe was a founding partner in the creation of the Centre for Research & Education on Violence Against Women & Children in 1992 and was the Academic Director from 2005-2021.

He's influenced generations of researchers, mental health professionals, lawyers, judges, school systems, families, and children. The Peter Jaffe Lectures on Ending Domestic Violence takes place annually and invites an anti-violence researcher to present a public lecture on their research.



Guess What Started Today in the House of Commons?

Pursuant to Standing Order 108(2), the House of Commons' Standing Committee on the Status of Women conduct a study on antifeminist ideology and its impacts on young Canadians' development and mental health; that the committee allocate at least four meetings to hearing witnesses; that the committee report its findings to the House; and that, pursuant to Standing Order 109, the committee request that the government table a comprehensive response to the report.



RACIALLY OR ETHNICALLY MOTIVATED VIOLENT EXTREMISTS

DVEs with ideological agendas derived from bias, often related to race or ethnicity, held by the actor against others, including a given population group.



ANIMAL RIGHTS/ ENVIRONMENTAL VIOLENT EXTREMISTS

DVEs seeking to end or mitigate perceived cruelty, harm, or exploitation of animals or perceived exploitation or destruction of natural resources and the environment.



ABORTION-RELATED VIOLENT EXTREMISTS

DVEs with ideological agendas in support of pro-life or pro-choice beliefs.



ANTI-GOVERNMENT VIOLENT EXTREMISTS

DVEs with ideological agendas derived from anti-government sentiment, including perceived economic hierarchies; or perceived government overreach, negligence, or corruption.

MILITIA VIOLENT EXTREMISTS

DVEs who take over or attempt to resist or facilitate the overthrow of the US Government in support of the US Government is perceived to be exceeding its Constitutional authority, or trying to establish a totalitarian regime, or oppose many federal and state regulations, particularly those related to firearms ownership.

ANARCHIST VIOLENT EXTREMISTS:

DVEs who oppose all forms of capitalism, corporate globalization, and governing institutions, which are perceived as harmful to society.

SOVEREIGN CITIZEN VIOLENT EXTREMISTS:

DVEs who believe they are immune from government authority and laws.



ALL OTHER DOMESTIC TERRORISM THREATS

DVEs with ideological agendas that are not otherwise defined under one of the other domestic terrorism threat categories, including a combination of personal grievances and beliefs with potential bias related to religion, gender, or sexual orientation.

GENDERED VIOLENCE

Why gender (and why now?)

1. 60% of mass violent attackers prior history of domestic/intimate violence
2. Rising DVE incl. male supremacist attacks
3. Women's engagement increasing
4. Crisis in men and boys' wellbeing
5. 'Moral panic' on LGBTQ+ issues
6. Anti-trans violence
7. Gender literally relegated to "other"
8. Argument: gender and misogyny are foundational to extremism and its violent outcomes






